Safety

The safety of our students is of utmost importance and there are several things that we can all do to ensure this:

- Please ensure that your child is not dropped off to school before 8:15am as there is no supervision before this time. Classrooms are opened and active supervision starts from 8:30am
- Children left at school to wait for parents are a concern. A duty teacher will roam the school at 3:10pm and collect all students who are not being supervised by an adult. They will be sent to the office to wait for their ride home, so please pick them up from there. If your child is still here by 3.30pm you will need to consider enrolling them in the After School Care service held at school.
- Parking in the bus bay, the grass verge of neighbours and within the school grounds
 poses huge safety problems for our children and our community. This term there will
 be parking wardens visiting our school. We have asked that they don't issue tickets on
 their first visit, but subsequent visits will incur fines for those that are parking in these
 areas.
- As summer draws near please consider parking two or three blocks away and enjoying the walk to school with your child.

2020

The end of the term is fast approaching and we are busy with the organisation for 2020. You can be assured that there is careful consideration given to placing your child in their whânau class. There are numerous factors that contribute to this decision - academic, social, emotional and learning strengths and needs. Teachers and Team Leaders know your child well and have significant input into placements.

We have made a decision to move Aroha Team into the buildings adjacent to the field (Whakapono Team this year) for 2020. This also means that Whakapono Team will then occupy the buildings at the top of the school (Aroha Team this year). The teams are looking forward to this move and the exciting learning that will take place in these teams.

I would like to take the opportunity to congratulate Annette Laban and Angela Cochrane who have been appointed as permanent, full time teachers at St Mary's. I would also like to congratulate Abbey Graham who has been appointed as a one year fixed term, full time teacher at St Mary's whilst Amber Armstrong is on maternity leave.
